EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT (EITC): The City of Philadelphia wants you to know about this important Federal Tax Credit!

See if you qualify for money today!

WHAT IS EITC? It's a special federal income tax credit for people who meet certain filing requirements. The amount of the credit ranges from \$496 to \$6,143!

HOW DO I GET IT?

You could qualify if you:

Get up to \$6,143 when you file your taxes!

- Meet income limits
- Have a valid Social Security number
- Are between 25 and 65 or have a qualifying child
- Meet filing status requirements
- Are not a qualifying child of another person
- Are a U.S. citizen or resident alien all year
- Meet all other requirements

Claim your Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)!

LOW INCOME CONSERVATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM: This FREE program is available to: Low-income homeowners and renters who have a water bill in their name.

Eligibility and Pre-screening

Eligibility is determined by the following criteria:

Applicant must be the customer of record. In the case of a tenant who is the water customer, a Landlord Consent Form must be signed prior to the audit and must be attached to the invoice.

Water bill must be in the applicant's name;

Household must have current water service and have an operable water meter;

Arrearage cannot exceed \$2,000.00 unless the household has been referred by the Water Revenue Bureau (WRAP);

Household income cannot exceed 200% of the federal poverty level.

Applicant must agree to the installation of all appropriate conservation devices recommended by the NEC. Conservation measures to be provided: Repair/replace leaking faucets, showerheads, minor pipe repairs and minor toilet repairs.
